I got the [OASP] package and opened it in front of my children (two high schoolers and middle schooler). They were surprised and excited about the idea that there really



Scholarship Eligibility

The Oregon Administrator Scholar's
Program (OASP) is offering scholarships up
to a **maximum of \$10,000** for racially or
linguistically diverse administrator candidates
accepted and enrolled in an approved
administrator program. The scholarships may be
used to pay for classes, fees, and related costs.
